Academician Vladimir Labunov celebrated his 85th anniversary!

Vladimir Labunov is a famous scientist in the field of microelectronics. Academician of the National Academy of Sciences of Belarus, foreign member of the Russian Academy of Sciences. Scientific advisor of the Research and Development Laboratory "Integrated Micro- and Nanosystems" of BSUIR. Doctor of Technical Sciences, Professor.



During the ceremonial meeting of the University Council on the occasion of the 60th anniversary of MRI-BSUIR, Rector Vadim Bogush said congratulatory words in honor of Vladimir Labunov's birthday: "I want to express special words to our respected Academician: Vladimir Labunov, please accept sincere congratulations and wishes for good health. Vladimir Labunov was born on March 16, 1939 in the city of Orsha, Vitebsk region. After graduating from school in 1956, he entered the Belarusian Polytechnic Institute. In 1963, Labunov entered the graduate school of the same institute, and in 1966 he defended his Ph.D. thesis, and in 1971, his doctoral dissertation. From 1966 to 1994 he is an assistant, associate professor, professor, head of the department of microelectronics at the Minsk Radioengineering Institute. From 1989 to 1991 - Member of the Supreme

Soviet of the USSR, member of the Committee for Science and Technology. Between 1994 and 2001 he performed diplomatic work: Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Republic of Belarus to Belgium, the Netherlands and Luxembourg, Permanent Representative of the Republic of Belarus to the European Communities and the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO). He has more than 250 scientific publications (personally and co-authored), including a monograph and 14 brochures, and more than 450 copyright certificates for inventions (personally and co-authored), a number of which were patented in industrialized countries. He trained more than 80 Ph.D. students, some of whom became doctors of science.
