

Summary

International exhibition of Cooperation Projects "Eurasia – Our Home"

The International Exhibition of Cooperation Projects "Eurasia - Our Home" took place June 7-9, 2023 at the Sirius Science and Art Park (Sochi, Russia). The exhibition was one of the events timed to coincide with the meetings of the Eurasian Intergovernmental Council, the CIS Council of Heads of Government, the III Eurasian Congress and the II Youth Forum of the CIS and EAEU.

The participants of these events visited the collective exposition of the section of the Ministry of Education of the Republic of Belarus. Among the honored guests of the exposition were Deputy Prime Minister of the Republic of Belarus I. Petrishenko, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Republic of Belarus to the Russian Federation D. Kruglov, Chairman of the Board of the Eurasian Economic Commission M. Myasnikovich, as well as a number of top officials of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Russian Federation.



Developments of BSUIR were represented by prototypes of control, measuring, and testing microwave equipment in the frequency range up to 220 GHz, ultrasonic installations, as well as equipment and hardware and software complexes for the aerospace industry.



The main results of BSUIR participation in the exhibition.

1. An agreement was reached with Innopolis University, Republic of Tatarstan, Russia, to initiate a joint application within the framework of the emerging programs of the Union State to develop an interstate online platform to improve digital literacy of faculty members and students
2. The possibility of implementation of joint programs of academic mobility of students in cooperation with the Department of International Cooperation of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Russian Federation, Russia has been worked out.
3. Negotiations with the Eurasian technological platform "Technologies of maintenance and repair of industrial equipment", Republic of Tatarstan, Russia, on the organization of serial production of ultrasonic equipment of BSUIR on the territory of Russia. And also negotiations were held with JSC "Active Component", Russia, on the use of ultrasonic equipment in the production of pharmaceutical substances.
4. A preliminary agreement was reached on the supply of absorbing power wattmeters to the Uzbek market with the assistance from the Association of Enterprises of Electrotechnical Industry of Uzbekistan.
