

Summary of BSUIR Participation at the “Made in Belarus” Exhibition in the framework of the XII Forum of Regions of Belarus and Russia

The Forum of Regions of Belarus and Russia took place on June 26 – 27 in Nizhny Novgorod, Russia.

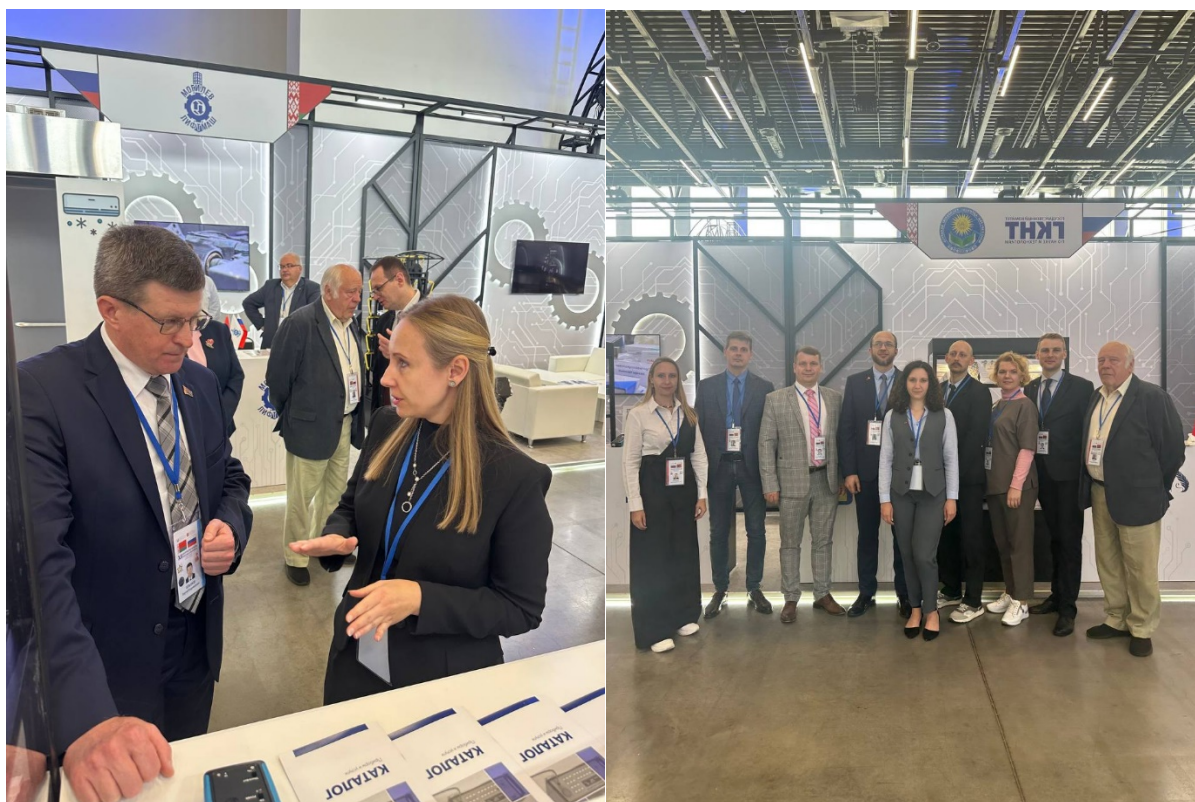
The Forum was organized by the Federation Council of the Federal Assembly of the Russian Federation and the Council of the Republic of the National Assembly of the Republic of Belarus. As part of the Forum, a **scientific and technological exhibition “Made in Belarus”** was held, in which BSUIR participated.

At the exhibition BSUIR presented:

- National standard of the unit of power of electromagnetic oscillations in the frequency range from 37.5 to 178.4 GHz.
- Microwave control, measuring and testing devices (such as G4-MWM, PM-MWM, PMC-MWM, SNA-MWM and VNA-MWM).
- Basic units and components of microwave and EHF ranges.
- All-weather long-range vehicle radar for collision avoidance of large vehicles.
- Portable cavitometers.
