Conditions of participation

- ✓ an application form (see Appendix 1);
- ✓ a paper formatted in accordance with the requirements (see Appendix 2) and using the **template**.

The articles will be published in the conference proceedings indexed in the Russian Science Citation Index (RSCI).

One person may be an author (co-author) of no more than two papers.

Authors of the best conference presentations will receive a recommendation for publication in the scientific journal “Doklady BGUIR”.

Note. No expert findings on the possibility of open publication are required.

Appendix 2. Requirements for Paper Formatting

The topic of the paper must demonstrate novelty, relevance, and practical significance.

Total length: 2–3 pages.

Language: Russian, Belarusian, or English.

Margins: 20 mm on all sides.

Line spacing: single.

Paragraph indent: 10 mm.

Font: Times New Roman.

Font size: main text and formulas – 14 pt, abstract, references, and author information – 12 pt.

Alignment: justified.

Automatic hyphenation is *required*.

Use of automatic lists is *not allowed*.

Structure of the paper:

– title in Russian (Belarusian);

– initials and surname(s) of the author(s) in Russian (Belarusian);

– affiliation(s) in Russian (Belarusian);

– abstract in Russian (Belarusian), 50–100 words;

– keywords (10 items) in Russian (Belarusian), separated by semicolons;

– title in English;

– initials and surname(s) of the author(s) in English (**must match previously published versions to avoid misindexing issues**);

– affiliation(s) in English;

– abstract in English, 50–100 words;

– keywords (10 items) in English, separated by semicolons;

– introduction;

– main body;

– conclusion;

– references in Russian (Belarusian);

– references in English (References);

– author information in Russian (Belarusian) and English.

It is allowed to include one figure or one table. The text must contain references to the figure (table). Captions and table titles must be in 12 pt (Times New Roman), centered, and provided in Russian (Belarusian) and English. No period is placed at the end. The font size in figures must be 12–14 pt.

All formulas must be created using MathType. Cyrillic and Greek symbols, as well as numbers and functions, should be in upright font; Latin symbols in italics.

The paper must be prepared using the **template** provided by the Organizing Committee.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to select and edit submitted papers.

Papers that do not meet the conference topics, formatting requirements, or are submitted after the deadline will not be considered.
